TO DISCUSS & AGREE PROPOSAL FROM CEFN RANGERS FOR YOUTH TEAM TO USE PITCH NEXT SEASON

The Clerk reported that she had received a request from the Chairman of Cefn Rangers FC asking if two youth teams could play on the pitch. U13's on a Saturday morning and U8's Sunday mornings. This arrangement would not have any impact on the teams playing later in the day. Following a discussion, it was resolved to allow the youth teams to use the pitch for the upcoming 2019/20 season, the same terms and conditions to apply stressing that the pitch is left in an acceptable condition for the next team playing. The key for the facility is only to be given to the chairman and secretary.
