**TO DISCUSS REMEMBRANCE SERVICE 2019**

Councillor P Vaughan welcomed all persons present to the meeting and passed over to Cllr D Wright to Chair the meeting. Councillor D Wright proceeded with this years' service and the following points were discussed and decided.

- Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November Start time of 10.40am - ***Resolved***
- Launch WW2 at Service or GE Hall – ***Resolved to launch at Cenotaph if time allows and at the GE Hall after the service***
- Chairs – ***Resolved to provide seating for approximately 80 persons***
- Decide on Hymns – ***Resolved to keep as last year, to include the full three versus of Calon Lan***
- Poems (Silent Stones & I Saw A Boy Marching) – ***Resolved to ask Ms Colvin for Silent Stones & Derrick Roberts confirmed he would be honoured to read I Saw A Boy Marching***
- March Past - Cadets did last year (Dave Humphreys stood aside) – ***Resolved to contact Mr Humphreys***
- Refreshments GE Hall Buffet – ***Resolved to hold refreshment at the GE Hall and to ask the schools to do teas/coffee on a yearly rota basis – Ysgol Cefn Mawr to be offered for 2019. The Clerk will contact all schools with the information and ask if they could bring along the school choir to perform at the GE Hall***
- Museum to display items at GE Hall, Play music from the era etc - ***Resolved and confirmed that the Museum will display items and play music if needed at the GE Hall***
- ***Practice Run on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November at 10.30a.m at the Cenotaph***

**TO DISCUSS & AGREE COURSE OF ACTION FOR 75 YEAR ANNIVERSARY FOR  
WORLD WAR TWO**

Councillor D Wright showed members present a presentation to launch the project for the World War Two Commemorations. The booklet will need to include public interest stories, photos etc as the number of named fallen soldiers on the memorial is not as great as the first World War. The booklet will include all names on the Memorial apart from those already researched. The booklet will need to be funded through a grant, if this is not forthcoming then a proposal will be made at the precept meeting of Full Council of 5-6k to cover all costs of the project which will include the booklets, visit to the National Arboretum and discos'. It was agreed for Cllr's D Wright and P Vaughan to initially approach the schools, show the presentation to the whole school and explain the procedure for the project. All members agreed.

- All schools be on steering committee – ***Resolved to leave committee as is***
- Ideally year 5 pupils to be involved – ***Resolved to request that year 5 pupils carry out the research***
- Booklet – extend for public stories, include people missed from WW1 booklet – ***Resolved to include***
